

77 ton concrete perimeter

for one of the UK's fastest growing forecourt operators.



Background

Clearway Services were called in to secure a vacant site situated on the A5, north of Birmingham and south of Cannock, which had recently been purchased by Euro Garages, one of the UK's fastest growing forecourt operators.

This vulnerable one acre site was susceptible to illegal occupation, trespassers had broken down the Heras fencing, taken up residency and set-off the internal alarm in the building.

Solution

After a lengthy eviction process, which resulted in the successful removal of the illegal occupiers from the site, we undertook a risk assessment and recommended a more robust security solution to prevent further incidents.

After having cleared the site of any rubbish, Clearway Services erected a total of 22 temporary vertical concrete barriers (TVCBs) at the entrance and exit to the newly cleared site.





The existing alarm was also replaced with a more effective alarm system.



Concrete blocks and barriers are resilient against the threat of illegal occupation.

Outcome

The concrete barriers being installed at the entrance and exit resulted in no further illegal vehicular access to the site. There were no further instances of anti-social behaviour.

No further incidents of rubbish being dumped were reported and the site remained clear.

The installation of a new alarm system prevented any more break-ins and the one acre site was soon being refurbished for use by Euro Garages. The whole process of securing the site took 3-4 days, and the new tenants were very pleased with the result.
